STAMFORD, Conn.--(BUSINESS WIRE)-- WWE Studios today announced that it will self-distribute and market its upcoming slate of nine films beginning with the summer release of the drama "Brother's Keeper" (working title) starring Patricia Clarkson, Danny Glover and WWE Superstar John Cena(R). Samuel Goldwyn Films will be WWE Studios' theatrical distribution partner in the U.S. Vivendi Entertainment will be WWE Studios' domestic DVD distribution partner.
