



House Minority Leader Nancy Pelosi Featured In Latest WWE Smackdown Your Vote! Podcast

House Minority Leader Nancy Pelosi is the latest national figure to be featured in a new podcast in Smackdown Your Vote!'s continuing series, "The Nowinski Perspective," hosted by WWE Political Correspondent Chris Nowinski(TM). It includes such partners as the League of Women Voters, National Association of Secretaries of State, the Harvard Institute of Politics and 18 to 35. Smackdown Your Vote! conducts voter registration at WWE live events, visits high schools and colleges, and provides materials and resources to encourage active participation in democracy.
